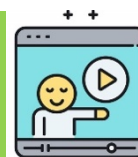




## ALPTREES iNaturalist “Train the Trainers” Workshop

We invite you to learn about iNaturalist, which is a citizen science mobile application and web-platform to explore nature around you and contribute to ecological challenges. How to engage people of different ages (from very young to old) to participate in activity, which is educational, scientific, practical, and outdoor? Biology teachers could find this handy tool useful to transfer knowledge in gaming and social networking way. Teachers of informatics could take over and further teach how to do spatial analysis of collected data. These are just a few ideas of what we are going to discuss at the Webinar. The particular focus of ALPTREES project is to improve knowledge-based decision-making on the responsible use and management of non-native tree (NNT) in the Alpine Space. We use iNaturalist to collect information on spatial distribution of NNT in the cities, parks and forests.
